

## Library Book Club



**September 4, 2013 The Shadow of the Wind** by Carlos Ruiz Zafon – Fiction – 2004 486 pages. The book is set in Barcelona, Spain during the Spanish Civil War. It follows a young boy who can no longer remember his mother's face.

# Los Angeles Public Library Photo Collection

The Library's Photo Collection focuses on the history of Los Angeles and dates from the 1880s to the present. Included are images from the historic Security Pacific National Bank collection and the photo morgues of the Los Angeles Herald Examiner and Valley Times newspapers. The entire collection has grown to 3 million images. Over 81,000 digital photos are already available on the Library's website.

The *Valley Times* photo collection, published in North Hollywood from 1946-1970 is in the process of being digitized and the Photo Friends (the official Friends group for the LA Library Photo collection) is asking for donations to help provide an additional archivist to assist with this project. 
